

Brief Program Descriptions

American Heart Association Delaware Hypertension Network	American Heart Association has convened the Delaware Hypertension Control Network to address the ongoing threat of hypertension by addressing measurement, treatment, and control of hypertension through patient self-monitoring, clinical training, and best practice treatment protocols. Program goal is to reduce stroke and heart disease through hypertension control in patients with low socioeconomic status.
Beebe Medical Foundation Family Medicine Residency Continuity Clinic	Beebe Medical Foundation's Family Medicine Residency Continuity Clinic will increase the medical education training and recruitment opportunities in Sussex County. The Clinic will allow resident providers to care for children and families, particularly in our underserved areas.
Brain Injury Delaware	The Brain Injury Webinar Series is now entering its second year, and serves as source of information, education and support for Delaware's Brain Injury Community. This webinar series provides life skills, resources and useful information on current trends and topics related to brain injury.
Cancer Support Community Delaware	Our Support Groups, Mind/Body Stress Reduction and Educational Programs are offered to cancer patients, caregivers, families, and survivors across the state at no cost. These virtual and in-person groups reduce anxiety and stress, as well as provide motivation for lasting behavioral change, leading to better treatment adherence and overall better outcomes.
Choir School of Delaware	Summer Camp at The Grand partners local arts organizations to guide students through process of putting on a musical production, inclusive of dance and social emotional and mental and physical health components.
Contact Lifeline	Its crisis helpline provides free 24/7 support to Delawareans struggling with suicidal ideation, depression, mental illness, and other trauma. It also can be used by the general public in need of information and referral services.
Delaware Health Equity Coalition	The goal of the Community Wellness Medical Home is to provide comprehensive, culturally competent, and pediatric health and wellness services to underrepresented and high-risk individuals living in the City of Wilmington DE.
Do Care Doula Foundation	The Community Doula program trains and supports doulas in order to provide a doula team for pregnant Delawareans to support them throughout their pregnancy, labor/childbirth, and postpartum improving the health outcomes of birthing parents and newborns.
Donate Delaware	Highmark supported the purchase of baby formula to aid families and individuals having difficulty finding formula during the shortage.
Healthy Foods for Healthy Kids	Growing Gardens and Expanding Minds teaches students the importance of healthy food choices, how to garden, as well as various science and agricultural concepts.
Into Light Project	Into Light will hold a Delaware exhibition and educational program to reduce the stigma of addiction by humanizing the lives of those lost to drug addiction and providing communities throughout DE with opportunities to learn about substance use disorder (SUD). This exhibit will be held at the Delaware Museum of Art June-December 2023.
Nemours Foundation	The Medical Legal Partnership program is a novel intervention that partners healthcare providers with legal aid attorneys to recognize and address health-harming legal needs that contribute to disparities in health outcomes.

Brief Program Descriptions

Tilton Society	This educational program, in partnership with the Delaware Medical Society, will educate practitioners to the opportunities Delaware offers for a robust and fulfilling medical career.
University of Delaware	Health, Engagement, Access, Learning, Teaching and Humanity for All is designed to increase access to care for underserved communities while training the next generation healthcare workforce and expanding students' understanding of social determinants of health (SDoH) through a collaborative, community-based approach.
Westside Family Healthcare	The Feeding Families program addresses social economic inequities that lead to chronic food insecurity and poor health outcomes. WFH will enroll a cohort of patients who identify as food insecure and have certain qualifying chronic conditions to measure clinical outcomes and behavior changes.
YMCA Delaware	Reducing Health Inequities is a comprehensive statewide health equity strategy focusing on advocacy and outreach, service delivery, and financial assistance designed to provide progressive services tailored to the needs of underserved communities.
