

## **Brief Program Descriptions**

AltruVision	The Gratis Tissue Fund program is improving the overall health and well-being of our local community by providing access to sight-restoring corneal transplants.
Catholic Charities	The access to behavioral health services program for underinsured individuals and families supplies resources and services to the local community to support gaps within insurance for mental and behavioral health. This program will increase access to behavioral health services, supporting decreases in anxiety, improved quality of life and improved substance abuse numbers.
Endless Possibilities in the Community Inc	The EPIC Strategic and Sustainable Expansion will expand EPIC's already successful program to additional YMCAs within New Castle County. EPIC's programs and skilled fitness staff provide a friendly and enabling environment for adult members with physical, intellectual, and developmental disabilities to exercise, learn about healthy living options, and build social skills.
The Challenge Program	The Challenge Program's pilot Mental Health Counseling Program for Vulnerable Young Adults will provide vital support to the participants of the Challenge Program, serving young adults, ages 18-24, who face significant barriers to employment and are at high risk of poverty, gun violence and criminal justice involvement.
TidalHealth	TidalHealth's Graduate Medical Education – Da Vinci Surgeon Console program aims attract and keep physicians who will provide quality care and improve population health and access for our communities in Sussex County. This project will add space and serve more Western Sussex County residents.
